## GALADRIEL BRACELET - by Teejay

## SUPPLIES:

- 15/0 seed beads (SB15)
- 11/0 seed beads (SB11)
- 8/0 seed beads (SB8)
- DiamonDuo beads (DD)
- Pinch beads or 4mm fire polished beads (PB)
- O-Beads (OB)
- Jump rings
- Clasp
- Fireline or Nymo B thread, about 3 yards


## MAKING THE CLASP LOOP MOTIF



1. Pick up two SB11 + SB8 + two SB11 + OB + DD (bottom hole) + OB + SB11 + PB + SB11 + PB + SB11 + OB. Leaving a tail long enough to weave in, go through the other hole of the DD.

Pick up one OB. Go back through the two SB11, SB8, two SB11, OB, DD, OB, SB11, PB, SB11, PB, SB11, OB, DD and OB. Tie a knot with the tail.
2. Go through the next two SB11. Skip the SB8 and go through the next two SB11. Pop out the SB8. Go on through the OB, DD, OB and the next SB11.
3. Pick up five SB15. Skip over the PB and go through the SB11 between the two PB. Push this strand of beads up and over the PB and into the center of the motif between the two PB. Do this every time that you add these strands of SB15's.
4. Pick up five SB15. Skip over the next PB and go through the next SB11. Go on through the OB, DD, OB and the next two SB11. Skip the SB8 and go on through the next two SB11, OB, DD, OB and SB11.
5. Go through all five SB15 of the first strand. Flip the work around and go through the first three SB15 of the second strand.
6. Flip the work again and go through the last three SB15 of the first strand. Pull these six SB15 close together. Go back around these six SB15 again to reinforce the connection. Exit through the SB11 on the end of the work.
7. Go on through the PB, SB11, OB, DD, OB, two SB11, SB8, two SB11, OB, DD, OB, SB11, PB and SB11.

## ADDING A CONNECTOR MOTIF

8. Pick up three SB11. Go back around and through the SB11 just exited. Go back around these four SB11 once again to reinforce. Exit through the SB11 on the end of the work.

NOTE: To add the final clasp loop motif, skip to step 20 after adding the connector.

## ADDING A DIAMONDUO/PINCH BEAD MOTIF

9. Pick up one $\mathrm{PB}+\mathrm{SB} 11+\mathrm{OB}+\mathrm{DD}($ bottom hole $)+\mathrm{OB}+\mathrm{SB} 11+\mathrm{PB}+\mathrm{SB} 11+\mathrm{PB}+\mathrm{SB} 11+\mathrm{OB}$. Go through the other hole of the DD.

Pick up one OB + SB11 + PB. Go back around and through the SB11 that you exited at the start of this step. Go back through all of these beads again and exit through the SB11 of the connector motif where you started this step.
10. Go on through the PB, SB11, OB, DD, OB and SB11. Pick up five SB15 and go through the SB11 on the end of the work.
11. Pick up five SB15 and go through the SB11 after the next PB. Go on through the OB, DD, OB and the next SB11.
12. Pick up five SB15 and go through the SB11 of the connector motif that is between the two PB.
13. Pick up five SB15 and go through the next SB11 after the PB. Go on through the OB, DD, OB and SB11.
14. Go through all five SB15 of the first strand. Flip the work around and go through the first three SB15 of the next strand.
15. Flip the work again and go through the last three SB15 of the first strand. Pull these six SB15 close together. Go back around these six SB15 again to reinforce the connection. Exit through the SB11 on the end of the work.
16. Go on through the PB, SB11, OB, DD, OB and SB11. Go through all five SB15 of the next strand.
17. Flip the work and go through the first three SB15 of the next strand. Flip the work and go through the last three SB15 of the other strand. Pull these six SB15 close together. Go back around these six SB15 again to reinforce the connection. Exit through the SB11 of the connector motif.
18. Go on through the PB, SB11, OB, DD, OB, SB11, PB and the SB11 on the end of the work.
19. Repeat steps 8-18 for the length of the bracelet minus the final clasp loop motif.

## ADDING THE FINAL CLASP LOOP MOTIF

20. You should be exiting the SB11 on the end of the last connector motif. Pick up one PB + SB11 + $\mathrm{OB}+\mathrm{DD}$ (bottom hole) $+\mathrm{OB}+$ two SB11 + SB8 + two SB11 + OB. Go through the other hole of the DD.

Pick up one OB + SB11 + PB. Go back around and through the SB11 that you exited at the start of this step.
21. Go on through the PB, SB11, OB, DD, OB and two SB11. Skip the SB8 and go through the next two SB11. Pop out the SB8.

Go on through the OB, DD, OB, SB11, PB, SB11, PB, SB11, OB, DD, OB and two SB11. Skip the

SB8 and go on through the two SB11, OB, DD, OB and SB11.
22. Pick up five SB15. Go through the SB11 of the connector motif.
23. Pick up five SB15. Skip over the PB and go through the next SB11. Go on through the OB, DD, OB, two SB11, SB8, two SB11, OB, DD, OB and SB11.
24. Go through all five SB15 of the first strand. Flip the work and go through the first three SB15 of the next strand.
25. Flip the work again and go through the last three SB15 of the first strand. Pull these six SB15 close together. Go back around these six SB15 again to reinforce the connection. Exit through the SB11 of the connector motif.
26. Weave in the working and tail threads. Attach the clasp with jump rings through the SB8's on the ends of the bracelet.
