

HONEYSUCKLE BRACELET

SUPPLIES:

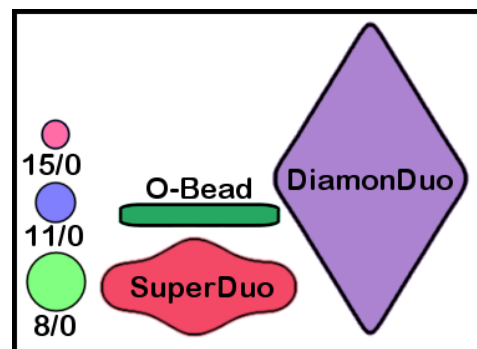
- 15/0 seed beads (SB15)
- 11/0 seed beads (SB11)
- 8/0 seed beads (SB8)
- DiamonDuo or GemDuo beads (DD)
- SuperDuo beads (SD)
- O-Beads (OB)
- Jump rings
- Clasp
- Nymo D thread or FireLine (about 2 yards)



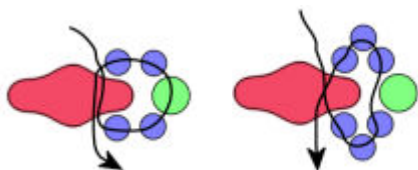
IDEA: This would also make a pretty necklace or ankle bracelet.

TIP: Whenever you pick up a DiamonDuo bead (DD), hold the bead face up horizontally and go up through the left hole. This will insure that all of your beads end up facing the right direction.

NOTE: You can make this bracelet with Toho seed beads but you might need to use fewer beads in Step 4 as noted.



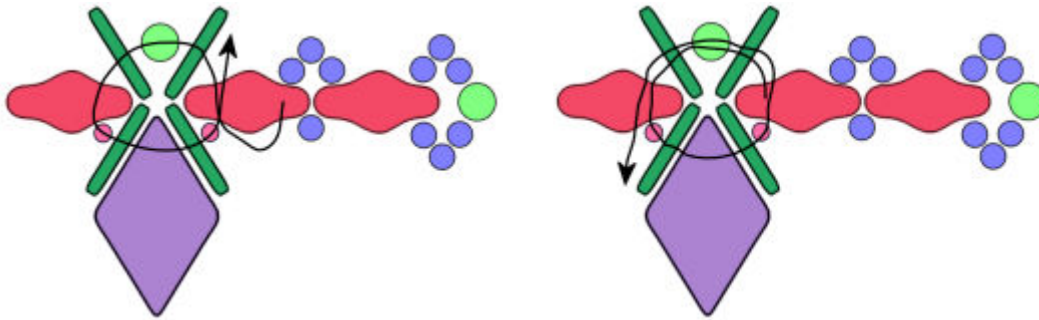
1. Pick up one SD + two SB11 + one SB8 + two SB11. Go back around through the SD and the five seed beads to make a circle leaving a tail long enough to weave in later. Tie a knot. Go on through the SD and the first SB11. Pick up one SB11 and go through the next SB11. Skip the SB8 and go through the next SB11. Pop out the SB8. Pick up one SB11 and go through the last SB11. Weave around the loop again, skipping the SB8 again. Weave around once more but go through all of the beads this time. Exit through the SD.



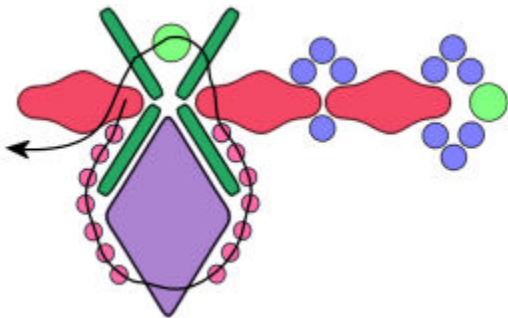
2. Go through the other hole of the SD. Pick up three SB11 + one SD + one SB11. Go back around and through the SD just exited. Go through the first of the three SB11. Skip the center SB11 and go through the third SB11. Pop out the skipped bead to make a picot. Go back around through the SD, SB11, the adjacent SD, three SB11 and SD pulling the beads snug.



3. Go through the other hole of the SD. Pick up one OB + one SB8 + one OB + one SD + one SB15 + one OB + one DD + one OB + one SB15. Go back around and through the SD just exited. Go back around these beads once again to reinforce, pulling the beads snug. Exit through the inner hole of the SD on the end.

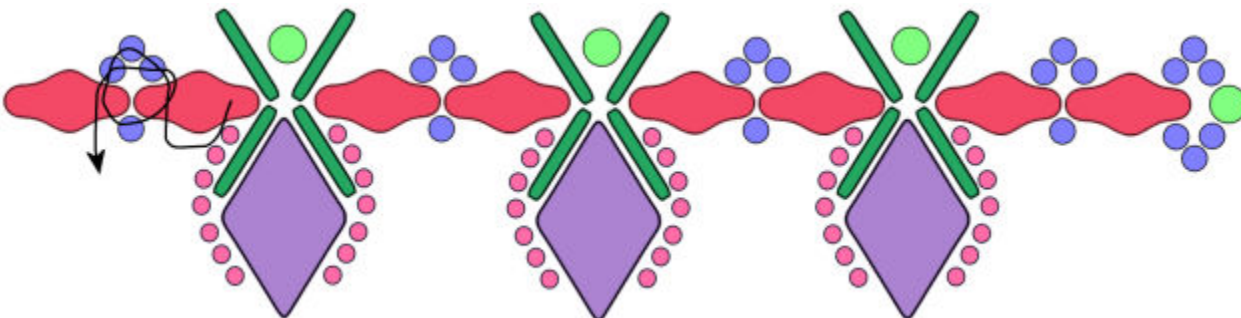


4. Go through the SB15. Pick up six SB15 (five with Toho beads) and go through the outer hole of the DD. Pick up six SB15 (five with Toho beads) and go through the next SB15. Go on through the SD, OB, SB8, OB and SD.

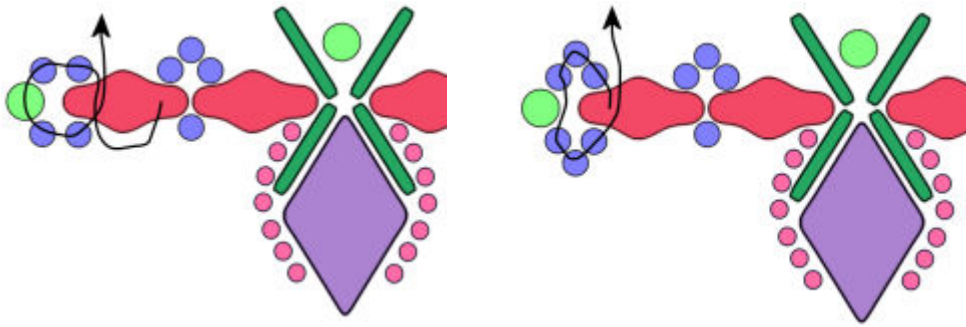


5. Repeat Steps 2-4 for the length of the bracelet minus about an inch. Go to Step 6 to complete the bracelet

6. Go through the other hole of the SD. Pick up three SB11 + one SD + one SB11. Go back around and through the SD just exited. Go through the first of the three SB11. Skip the center SB11 and go through the next SB11. Pop out the skipped bead to make a picot. Go back around through the SD, SB11, SD, three SB11 and SD pulling the beads snug.



7. Go through the other hole of the SD. Pick up two SB11 + one SB8 + two SB11. Go back around and through the same hole of the SD just exited. Go through the next SB11. Pick up one SB11 and go through the next SB11. Skip the SB8 and go through the next SB11. Pop out the SB8. Pick up one SB11 and go through the last SB11. Weave around the loop again, skipping the SB8 again. Weave around once more but go through all of the beads this time.



8. Weave in the working and tail threads. Attach the clasp by inserting a jump ring through each of the SB8 beads on the ends and attach the clasp to the jump rings.
